HOW TO DO A IN 30 MINUTES

1. LOCATION

Ask the volunteer for a location that they would like to meet at - It's a smart way to be courteous, get to know the person, and explore the local community.

3. JUMP INTO IT

Get straight into it - Explain why you're meeting folks in the community and transition into your personal story...

5. GAME PLAN

Share the game plan! Talk about your organizing neighborhood and the campaign goals, doors to knock and calls to make, etc.

7. WRAP UP & FOLLOW UP

Gauge the response and follow-up!

Make sure to send a note in the same day to thank them regardless of their response.

2. BE PRESENT

Be on time for the meeting and be present! Put your phone away and be attentive to the person you're meeting with.

4. STORY TIME

Try to open up the conversation so that they may share their personal story with you. Connect pieces between the two stories - This establishes common values and shared interests.

6. THE HARD ASK

Every meeting should end with an ask of the person you're with to take on a new task, sign up for a shift to hit your goals, or more responsibility.

Don't be afraid to ask for bigger commitments than you might expect of the person. Start big in the ask and then work your way down.
